Dear Parents and Future Curlers,

We are excited to be teaming up with the Innisfail Curling Club again this year to offer curling at St. Marguerite Bourgeoys School!

There will be a try-it event on October 30th from 4pm - 5:30pm. This is a great opportunity to come try out the sport and sign up for the season if you like it.

The official curling season starts on November 6th and runs until the middle of March 2025. There are weekly practices on Wednesdays, plus opportunities for exhibition games and bonspiels. We will also be having a fun family bonspiel to wrap up the season, where parents, grandparents and/or guardians can join in and curl with their kiddos.

## There are two programs offered:

- Little Rocker Program\* for youth ages 8-12 years old; Wednesdays 4-5pm
- Junior Program: ages 12 and up; Wednesday 4-5:30pm
- \* Little Rock Parents: Curlers in this age group are required to wear protective head equipment, which we will provide. We may run a second session from 5-6pm on Wednesdays depending on numbers.

Fees: \$125, payable to the Innisfail Curling Club. This includes all equipment.

**Equipment:** All equipment is provided by the club and is to be returned at the end of the season; please **bring clean running shoes** to each practice.

<b>Transportation</b> : Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child gets to and from practices and games. Practices are held at the Innisfail Curling Club every Wednesday. Students may sign up for away bonspiels, however it is not mandatory. Parents would be responsible for ensuring that they can transport their child to extra events.
